About Emeritus Membership

In June 2013, a new membership category – Emeritus Membership – was approved by the NACUA Board of Directors, thanks to the great work of the 2011-2012 Advisory Group on Continued Engagement of Long-Time NACUA Members and the 2012-2013 Committee on Membership and Member Services.

Many NACUA members who are approaching retirement or have retired wish to remain connected with their NACUA colleagues. NACUA in turn, especially our newer and younger members, will benefit from the knowledge, experience and expertise that these individuals bring to the membership, to meetings and to conversations, both professionally and personally.

Eligibility

The Emeritus Membership is open to individuals who are fully retired from the practice of law and are not otherwise eligible to be either a representative of a regular institution or an associate institution, or to be an associate individual member. Individuals must have been a member of NACUA in good standing for a minimum of ten(10) years prior to eligibility for this category. Individuals will not be required to maintain active licensure in any state.

Please Note: Individuals are not eligible for this membership category if they are, or will be, engaged on either a limited or regular basis in legal matters on behalf of colleges and universities.

Member Benefits

Emeritus members receive all current NACUA benefits, including participation on NACUANET. Emeritus members may attend any NACUA continuing legal education program (including the Annual Conference) at 50% of the regular (early) member rates. Emeritus members are also encouraged to participate in the ongoing work of the Association through committee service.

Contingency*

Membership is contingent on review and approval by NACUA Staff, Chair of the Committee on Membership and Member Services, and the Board of Directors at their in-person meeting in March, June, or November. After review, memberships that are approved will be activated within 24-48 hours.
